

# Mount Lindesay Highway – Rosia to Stoney Camp Road Upgrade

## Start of Major Construction

November 2019

The Department of Transport and Main Roads is delivering state government funded \$20 million upgrade on the Mount Lindesay Highway between Rosia Road and Stoney Camp Road at Park Ridge South.

Hazell Bros Group Pty Ltd has been appointed to construct the project that began in early November 2019 and continue until late 2020 (weather and construction conditions permitting).

### About the project

The upgrade will widen the highway to four lanes between Rosia Road and Stoney Camp Road and improve the on-ramp at Stoney Camp Road and off-ramp at Granger Road.

The road works will involve:

- earthworks and pavements
- street lighting and traffic cameras
- under road drainage
- safety barriers
- signage
- landscaping
- pavement markings.

### Construction Works

Construction activities in November and December will include:

- Speed limits reduced to 60km/h on Mount Lindesay Highway during construction.
- Set up of temporary site offices near the cement works for the project team.
- Installation of concrete traffic barriers on the Mount Lindesay Highway to separate work areas from traffic.
- Linemarking and removal of existing lines on the Mount Lindesay Highway.
- Remove excess topsoil and material from the construction site using trucks.

### Working hours

Standard work hours and days will be Monday to Saturday 7am – 5pm.

From time to time, work outside of these of times may be required due to safety reasons, or in case of an emergency.

Works to be undertaken outside of standard working hours during March include the installation of concrete barriers and line-marking on the Mount Lindesay Highway.

### What to expect

- Changed traffic conditions including reduced speed limits, short-term traffic stoppages and temporary lane closures.
- Residents near the work zone may experience increased noise, dust and vibration.
- Movement of large construction equipment and machinery and use of vehicles and machinery fitted with flashing lights and reversing beepers for safety reasons.
- Construction traffic entering and exiting work areas and site offices.
- Changes to some property accesses.

Every effort will be made to minimise construction impacts where possible.
